Key focus areas included during the door-to-door campaign was improving children's attendance in the centers; addressing the rising cases of diarrhoea due to the monsoon season; Promoting proper handwashing techniques to prevent infections; Encouraging intake of fresh fruits and nutritious food; Emphasizing the use of clean and safe drinking water, etc. Together, we are building healthier homes and brighter futures—one household at a time.



Awareness on Importance of Breast Feeding

NIPUN recently organized an awareness cum sensitization program for mothers working as construction site labourers and daily wage earners at Delhi/NCR where NIPUN is actively working, focusing on the importance of breastfeeding and overall maternal and child health. Recognizing the dual challenges these women face—balancing strenuous work with caregiving responsibilities—the session aimed to equip them with knowledge and support to nurture their children effectively. The program included interactive discussions, counselling sessions, and mentoring, creating a safe space for mothers to express their concerns and seek guidance. Key topics covered during the session included the importance of exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months, the nutritional needs of lactating mothers, and the significance of personal health and hygiene for both mother and child. Through these engagements, the mothers gained practical insights on how to maintain a healthy diet, ensure cleanliness, and create a nurturing environment even amidst challenging working conditions. The initiative not only raised awareness but also fostered confidence and solidarity among the women.

By empowering mothers with knowledge and support, NIPUN continues to strengthen the foundation for healthier children and resilient communities.

Caring for Children at NIPUN's Crèche, Nihal Vihar

At Nihal Vihar in West Delhi, NIPUN runs a Daycare cum Crèche Center for children whose parents work tirelessly as domestic helpers, construction workers, and daily wage earners. The center currently supports 42 children from nearby communities. However, it is concerning to note that over 45% of these children are malnourished — with 14 moderately underweight and 5 severely underweight.

To address this, NIPUN organizes regular health check-up camps, where each child's height, weight, and BMI are monitored. Children are served delicious, hot, nutritious meals, while those identified as malnourished receive a special diet to improve their health. Additionally, we conduct regular one-on-one counseling sessions with mothers, guiding them on ways to maintain and improve their child's health and nutrition.

Together, we strive to ensure every child grows up healthy, happy, and full of hope.



Nurturing Dreams at NIPUN's Day Care cum Crèche

At Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh, NIPUN runs Day Care cum Crèche Centers for the children of construction workers, providing them with a safe and nurturing space while their mothers work hard to earn a livelihood. Most of these children are either first-generation learners, school dropouts, or have never attended school. Through our centers, we not only provide quality education but also engage them in learning about the environment, mathematics, language, life skills, Indian culture, emotional care, and the value of sharing.

Alongside education, we ensure their holistic development by offering nutrition, health check-ups, and life skill training — empowering children and, in turn, their families. Our ultimate goal is to mainstream them into MCD/Government schools, opening the doors to a brighter future.



Bal Vatika & ASHA Workers: Strengthening Early Childhood Care

NIPUN's Bal Vatika Project team recently met with 10 ASHA workers of Kapashera to strengthen efforts towards child and maternal health. The meeting aimed at ensuring routine immunisation, promoting nutrition, and creating healthier environments for children and families.

ASHA workers shared their roles, responsibilities, and challenges in the community, while the Bal Vatika team highlighted the project's objective of providing early childhood care, education, and health support to children of working parents.

Both teams agreed to collaborate on key areas including routine immunisation, health awareness drives, growth monitoring, and mother's counselling sessions on hygiene and nutrition. Plans were also made for monthly coordination meetings, training workshops, and joint health camps in the coming months.


