

World AIDS Day 2021:

The theme of this year World AIDS Day is "End inequalities, End AIDS"

NIPUN Vocational Education Centre observed World AIDS Day on December 1 2021 and organised an awareness programme on the life threatening disease and its prevention & control.

Forty (40) young entrepreneurs trained in self employed tailor, beauty and wellness & computer courses actively participated the program. The awareness programme ended with an interactive question and answer session.

Sensitisation programme for transgenders:

A community sensitisation programme was organised by NIPUN under Targeted Intervention Project at Kapashera Border, South West District, Delhi facilitating registration for Voter Identity Card during the Dilli Ka Voter Utsav. NIPUN team mobilized community through door to door visits and individual counselling sessions.



During the "Chalo Voter Bane Hum" campaign, 113 transgenders registered for Voter Identity Card. NIPUN expresses gratitude to the Office of the District Magistrate, South West District for providing an opportunity at the door step of the transgender community.



Awareness Programme on POCSO Act 2012 at NIPUN

Delhi State Legal Services Authority, West District organised an awareness programme on Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 on December 1, 2021 which was attended by team members of NIPUN and youth.

Advocate Shri. Raj Gaurav explained about rights, duties, offences and punishments provided under the Act in an interactive session where participants put across their doubts which were promptly resolved by the resource person. A video was also showed to the participants to make them well informed and aware about nuances of Sexual Offences among children.

The session ended with a pledge that the participants would spread the information about the Act with their friends, family members and neighbours. Forty one (41) participants actively attended the session.

Growth Monitoring cum Health Check up Camp

Monthly Growth Monitoring cum routine health check up camp was organised to review / analyse the growth of the 180 children who are residing at construction sites, NOIDA and enrolled at NIPUN Day Care Centres. During the Check up programme, Dr. Kalyani Mishra reviewed the height, weight, immunisation, deworming status and skin of each Child. 180 children in the age group from birth to 12 years which covered 96 girls and 84 boys registered for the camp.

According to the diagnosis, doctors have recommended treatment /special diet including protein, iron, and calcium to 33 children and advised extra care for malnourished children and conducted counselling sessions with mothers and their day care workers for better care of the children.

A well wisher of NIPUN gifted games like building blocks, puzzles, soft toys and other educational aid which will benefit the children in improvement of social, language, concentration, communication, creative thinking, leadership, confidence, team work and critical analysis.


