Empowering Youth for a Drug-Free Future

On the occasion of National Youth Day (Swami Vivekananda Jayanti), NIPUN, in collaboration with the West District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) under the aegis of NALSA and DSLSA, organized a sensitization programme in Nihal Vihar, West Delhi, focusing on the prevention of drug abuse and awareness of its legal consequences under the NDPS Act. Conducted under the DAWN Scheme – For a Drug-Free India, the programme engaged street-connected children and youth from urban slum communities, aiming to educate them about the risks of substance abuse and the importance of informed, responsible decision-making.

Through interactive discussions and legal awareness sessions, the initiative empowered young participants with essential knowledge, encouraged positive behavioural change, and inspired them to pursue healthier and more purposeful lives. NIPUN continues to work collaboratively with stakeholders to strengthen community awareness, promote youth well-being, and contribute to building a drug-free and socially responsible society.

Building Healthy Habits from an Early Age!

Under the Bal Vatika Project, NIPUN organised engaging Personal Health & Hygiene awareness sessions for children and families in Kapashera, South West Delhi, focusing on building healthy habits from an early age. The sessions were interactive and child-friendly, using demonstrations and IEC materials to make hygiene education simple, practical, and engaging.

Children were sensitised on essential practices such as regular handwashing with soap, use of toilets and stopping open defecation, wearing chappals, nail cutting, clean clothing, daily brushing, and regular bathing.

These sessions helped children understand how small daily habits can protect them from illness and improve overall well-being. To reinforce learning beyond the centres, liquid hand wash was distributed and hygiene-related IEC materials were displayed at Bal Vatika centres and community spaces. This has contributed to improved hygiene practices at home, increased parental awareness, and a visible reduction in common hygiene-related illnesses. Children are now confidently sharing these messages with their families, becoming young ambassadors of healthy living.



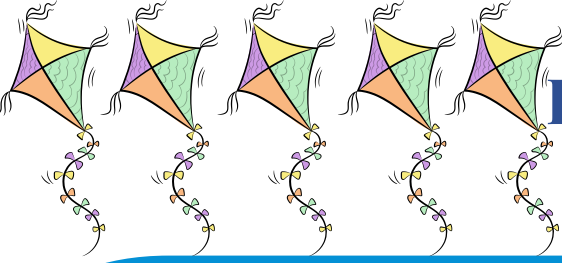
Celebrating National Youth Day with Creativity & Inspiration

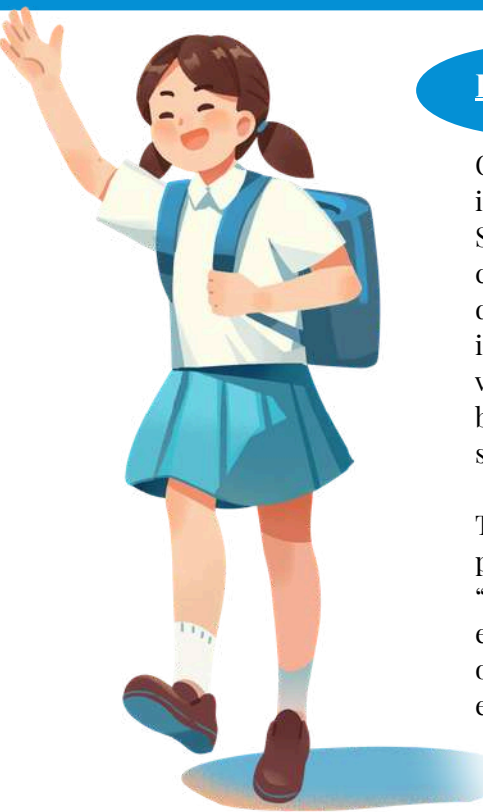

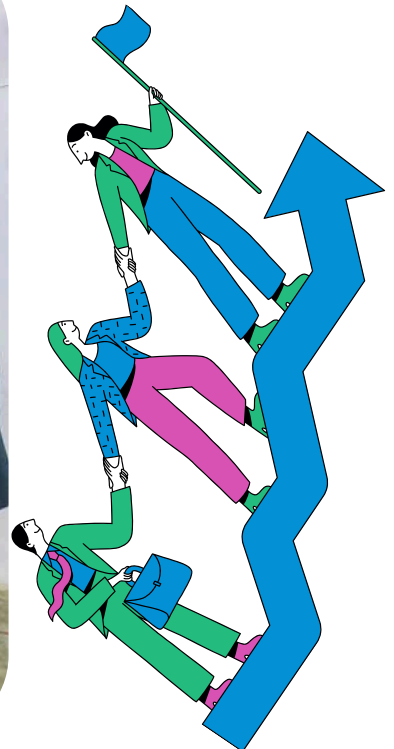

Together, we continue to work towards brighter futures for children.

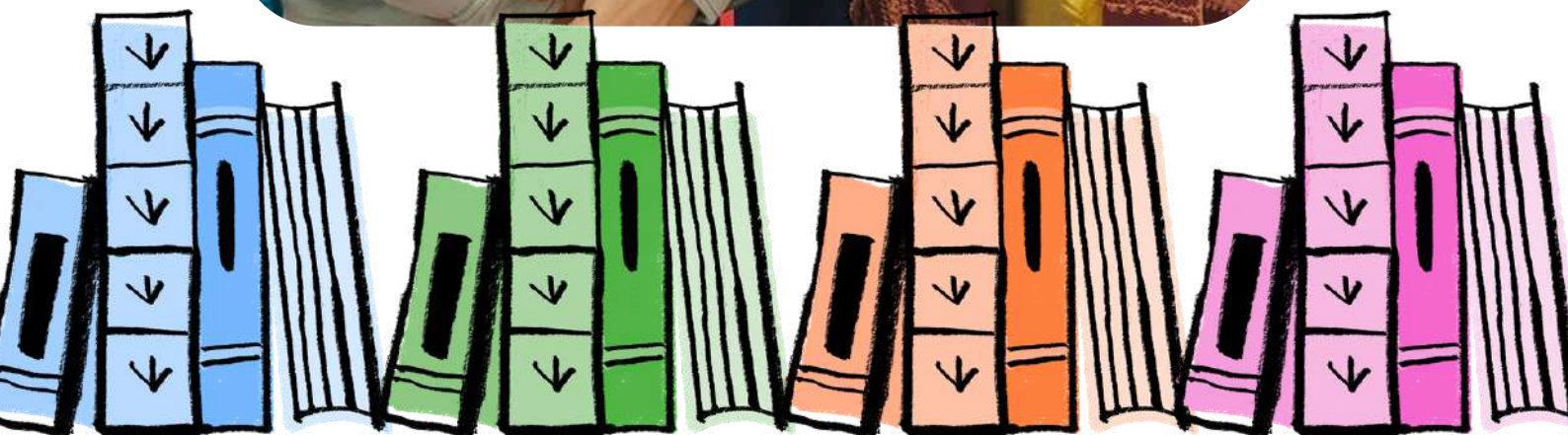
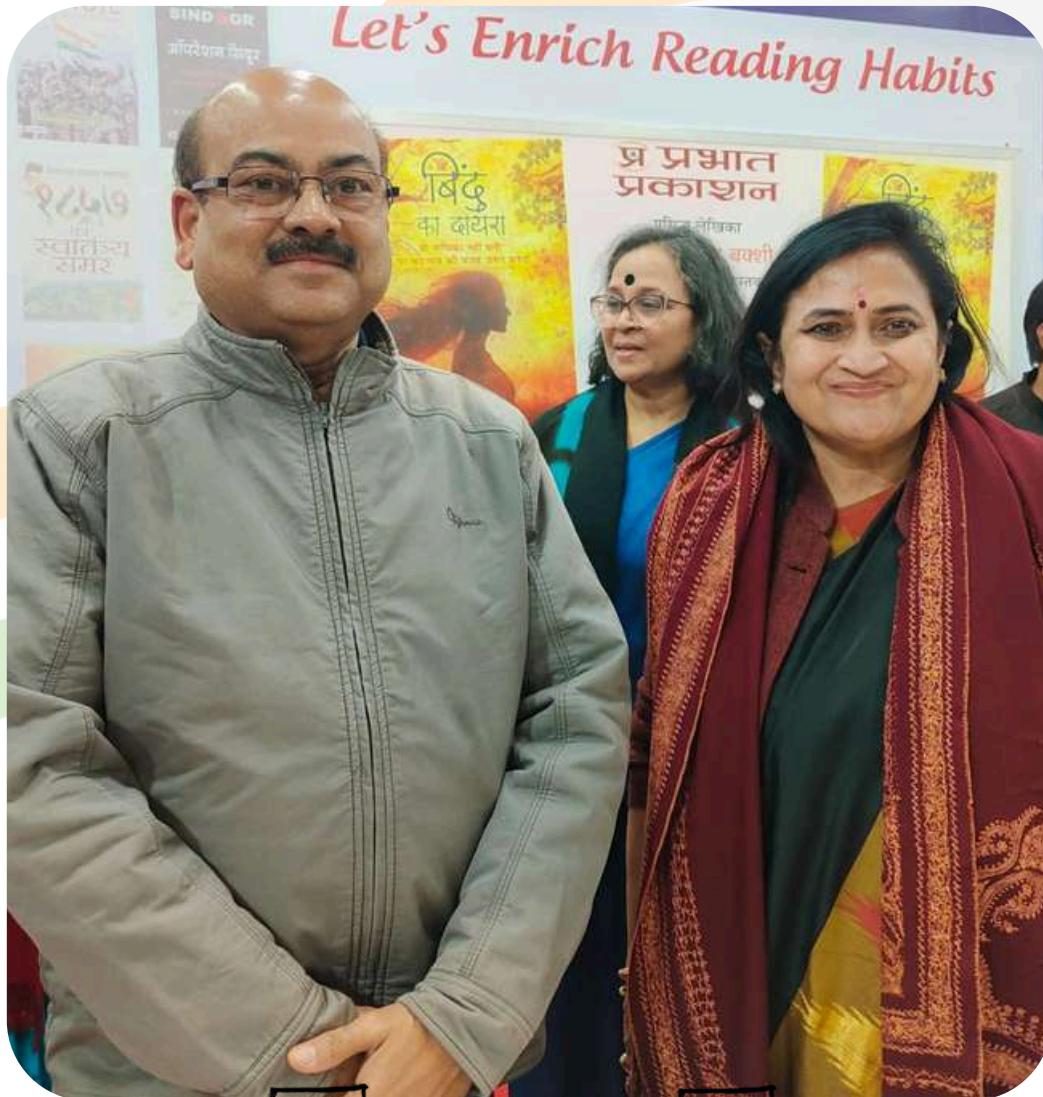


Celebrating the Joy of Reading
