Ratri AIDS Suraksha Camp | Reaching the Unreached



As part of the Ratri AIDS Suraksha Campaign, NIPUN's Transgender Targeted Intervention (TG-TI) Project conducted special late-evening outreach and screening camps from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM, reaching high-risk individuals who may often remain unreached during regular daytime outreach. Through intensive community mobilisation, counselling and risk assessment, 201 individuals were screened for HIV, of whom 8 were found reactive, and 5 were referred to ICTC for confirmatory testing and further follow-up. Additionally, 201 individuals were screened for Syphilis, with 14 found reactive and linked for appropriate referral and care.

The campaign reflects NIPUN's commitment to taking essential health services closer to communities—at the right place and at the right time—while promoting early detection, timely referral and stronger linkages to treatment and care. Reaching the unreached. Testing early. Linking to care. Moving closer to ending AIDS.

Through our Vocational Training Centres in West Delhi and South-West Delhi, NIPUN equips youth, particularly young women from underserved communities, with practical and market-oriented skills that create pathways to employment, self-employment, entrepreneurship, and sustainable livelihoods.

Our programmes include Basic Computer Training, Tally & Accounting, Beauty & Wellness, Tailoring & Dress Designing, Retail Management, Spoken English, and Personality Development. Alongside vocational training, we integrate soft skills, life skills, communication, financial literacy, confidence-building, and workplace readiness—preparing young people not just for jobs, but for life and leadership. The journey towards Viksit Bharat 2047 will be driven by the skills, aspirations, innovation, and participation of India's youth. By ensuring that young people—regardless of their social or economic background—have access to relevant skills and livelihood opportunities, we can build a future that is inclusive, resilient, sustainable, and shared by all.

Monthly Health Check-up & Growth Monitoring | Bal Vatika Project

At NIPUN, every child's healthy growth matters. Under our Bal Vatika Project, a Monthly Health Check-up cum Growth Monitoring Camp was organised to regularly assess the health, nutrition, and overall development of children. Following World Health Organization (WHO) growth monitoring guidelines, children were examined by an experienced MBBS doctor, with careful monitoring of their height, weight, growth status, and overall health condition. Children identified with malnutrition receive focused attention, regular follow-up, and special nutritious diets to support their recovery and healthy development. Our objective is clear: to help every malnourished child progress on the journey from SAM to MAM and ultimately to normal nutritional status – from Severe Acute Malnutrition to Moderate Acute Malnutrition to healthy growth.

Through regular growth monitoring, timely medical intervention, supplementary nutrition, special diets, counselling of parents, and continuous follow-up, NIPUN is working to ensure that no child's potential is limited by malnutrition. From SAM to MAM to Normal – every improvement is a step towards a healthier childhood and a brighter future.



HIGHLIGHTS

Mega Legal Services Camp Organised at NIPUN NGO, Meera Bagh

NIPUN was privileged to host the Mega Legal Services Camp under the pilot project "Community Legal Empowerment through Health & Childcare Platforms", organized by the West District Legal Services Authority (WDLA) in collaboration with Delhi State Legal Services Authority (DSLDA), Delhi Police (Cyber Cell & Narcotics Unit), Rotaract Club of Delhi Heights, and other esteemed stakeholders. The camp brought together multiple essential services under one roof, providing free legal aid, legal counselling, legal awareness, cyber safety education, information on government welfare schemes, and access to public welfare services for marginalized and vulnerable communities.

A special School Admission (Dakhila) Camp was also organized to facilitate children's enrolment in schools, reaffirming the collective commitment to ensuring every child's right to education. Additionally, 34 Ayushman Bharat Health Cards were successfully registered, enabling eligible families to access quality healthcare benefits. Adding a vibrant community engagement component, an interactive puppet show captivated children and families while spreading powerful messages on girl child education, child rights, gender equality, health, hygiene, and other important social issues. The programme witnessed the active participation of Learned Legal Aid Counsels, Para Legal Volunteers, Delhi Police officials, Rotaract Club members, and community volunteers, who worked together to ensure that justice, education, healthcare, and government services reached those who need them the most.

The Mega Legal Services Camp stands as a shining example of convergence, collaboration, and community empowerment, strengthening access to justice and essential services while advancing the vision of an inclusive and empowered society. Together, we are making legal services, education, healthcare, and government welfare accessible to every citizen—right at their doorstep.

HCV Screening Target Achieved | Strengthening Community Health

NIPUN Targeted Intervention (TI), Batala, with the support of the Punjab State AIDS Control Society (PSACS) and the National AIDS Control Organisation (NACO), successfully organized an Hepatitis C (HCV) Screening Camp at a hotspot for the High-Risk Group (HRG) community.

A total of 249 HRGs were screened for Hepatitis C, out of which 20 individuals were found HCV reactive. They have been counselled and linked to the appropriate healthcare facilities for further confirmatory testing, treatment, and follow-up care.



We are proud to announce that NIPUN TI Batala has successfully achieved its HCV screening target, reflecting our continued commitment to early detection, timely intervention, and improving health outcomes among vulnerable populations. Through sustained outreach, screening, counselling, and referral services, NIPUN remains dedicated to supporting the national mission of reducing the burden of HIV and viral hepatitis while ensuring that quality healthcare reaches those who need it the most.

Building Strong Foundations Through Early Childhood Care

At NIPUN's Bal Vatika Centres, we believe that healthy habits begin in early childhood. Every day, children are encouraged to wash their hands with soap and clean water before meals and after using the toilet. Empowering Youth for a Safer Digital Future

With the rapid growth of digital technology and online connectivity, creating awareness about cyber safety has become more important than ever. To promote responsible digital behaviour, NIPUN organized a Cyber Crime Awareness and Sensitisation Programme for the youth of the J.J. Clusters of Meera Bagh, West Delhi. The session focused on educating young people about the increasing risks of cyber crimes, including online fraud, phishing, identity theft, cyberbullying, and social media misuse.



Participants were sensitised on the importance of protecting their personal information, using strong digital security practices, and exercising caution while engaging on online platforms. The programme also introduced participants to cyber laws, safe internet practices, and the mechanisms available for reporting cyber crimes. Through interactive discussions and real-life examples, the youth gained valuable insights into becoming informed, responsible, and vigilant digital citizens capable of protecting themselves and supporting others in their communities. Bachpan Ki Suraksha, Hamari Zimmedari!

NIPUN organised a community sensitisation programme on "Bachpan Ki Suraksha – Apradh se Roktham" at its Bal Vatika Centre in South West Delhi to create awareness among children, parents, and community members about child safety and the prevention of crimes against children.

During the interactive session, 125 participants were sensitised on recognising unsafe situations, understanding the concept of Good Touch and Bad Touch, the importance of speaking up, and seeking timely support from trusted adults. The programme also highlighted key child protection measures, emergency helpline services, and the collective responsibility of families and communities in ensuring a safe and secure environment for every child.

Ratri AIDS Suraksha Camp | Extending Healthcare Beyond Daylight

On 24 July 2026, NIPUN's Targeted Intervention (TG-TI) Project successfully organised a Ratri AIDS Suraksha Camp in the South West District of Delhi to reach members of the high-risk community during late evening hours, when they are more accessible and often missed through routine daytime outreach. During the camp, 55 individuals were screened and the community was sensitised on HIV prevention, safer practices, and the importance of regular testing. The team also provided individual risk assessment and counselling, encouraging participants to make informed decisions about their health and well-being. To reinforce key messages, Information, Education and Communication (IEC) materials were distributed, promoting awareness on HIV prevention, early diagnosis, and access to healthcare services.

The initiative reflects NIPUN's continued commitment to ensuring that vulnerable communities have access to accurate information, quality counselling, and essential health services. By taking awareness and prevention efforts directly to the community, we are strengthening the pathway towards early detection, timely care, and a healthier future for all. Together, we are breaking barriers, spreading awareness, and bringing healthcare closer to those who need it the most.

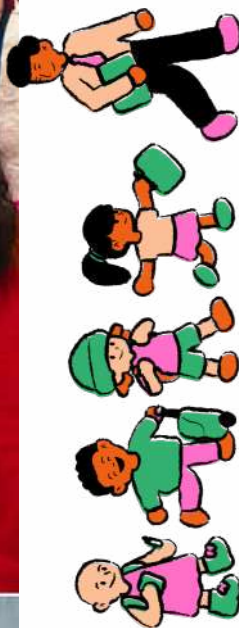
