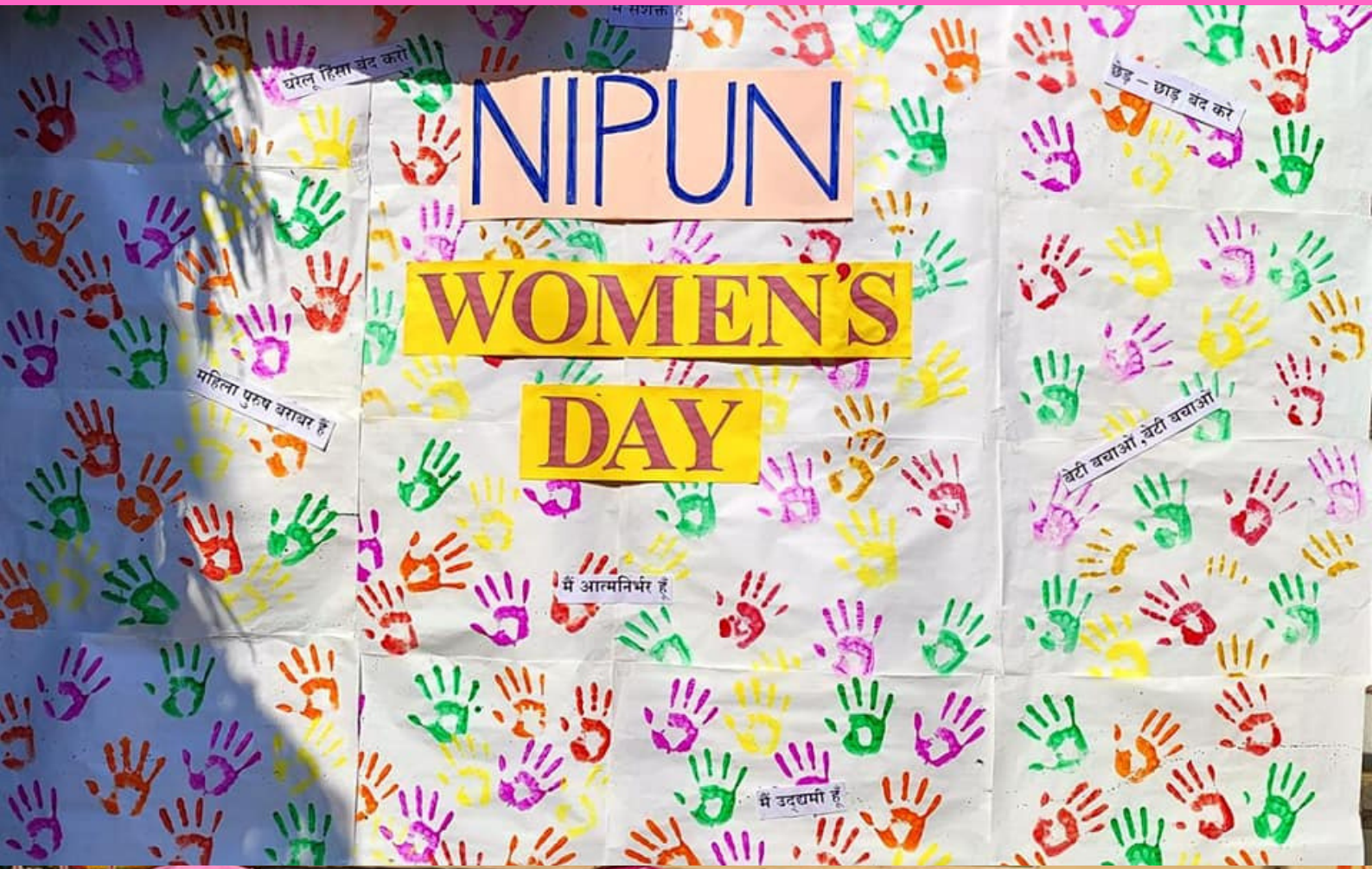

Childhood and adolescence are the developmental periods during which one acquires these skills through various methods and people. The purpose of the workshop was to empower the adolescent girls on life skills.

The topic covered during the workshop was self-awareness, empathy, decision making, problem solving, critical & creative thinking, goal setting, coping with emotion & stress. Play way methods were used to impart the above information to attract maximum attention of the audience.

## World Water Day 2023

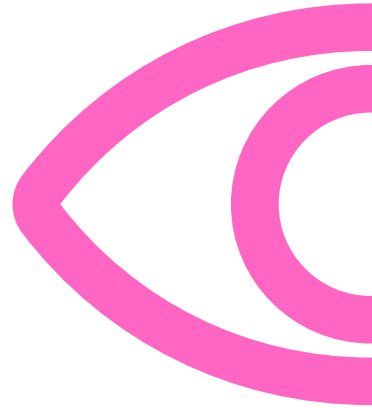

## Free Eye Check-up Camp

An Eye Check-up camp was organised at NIPUN Vocational Training Center, Nihal Vihar, New Delhi on 31st March, 2023 with the support of Sahyog Foundation.

During the camp, 152 beneficiaries were screened for any eye ailment. Spectacles were provided to 53 beneficiaries free of cost and 11 beneficiaries were referred for additional physical examination for cataract operation.
