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MOTHERS' DAY

To address this critical issue, NIPUN operates several Day Care cum Crèche Centres across Delhi and NCR. These centers provide comprehensive early childhood care and education to over 1200 underprivileged children between the ages of 0 to 6 years. The services include regular health check-ups, immunizations, nutritious meals to combat malnutrition, and nonformal education to help bridge learning gaps. Most importantly, these centers offer a safe and nurturing environment, protecting children from neglect, abuse, and exploitation, and preparing them for enrollment in nearby government schools. By offering dependable childcare support, NIPUN enables mothers to pursue work opportunities, gain financial independence, and contribute actively to the economy—without having to compromise on the care of their children.

Empowering Mothers, Enrolling Futures!

NIPUN recently conducted an awareness drive under the Bal Vatika Project in South West Delhi to sensitize and motivate mothers about the importance of formal education for their children.

Our Nutrition Project is a lifeline for the children of construction workers—offering not just care, but compassion and opportunity. Through our dedicated Day Care Centre, we provide a safe, nurturing space where children aged o-5 years can grow, learn, and thrive. It's more than a shelter—it's a foundation for brighter tomorrows. Nutrition is at the heart of what we do. With freshly cooked, wholesome meals, we help fuel their potential and fight malnutrition. Because we know: healthy bodies build healthy minds.

Each month, we conduct Health Check-up & Growth Monitoring Sessions, led by Dr. Kalyani Mishra (MBBS) and her committed team. These sessions track vital health indicators—height, weight, immunization status, and overall nutrition—ensuring every child receives the care and attention they deserve. 115 children were checked and Children identified as malnourished are provided with special diets to support their recovery. Together, we're building a healthier, stronger future—one child at a time.

At NIPUN, we believe that true change begins at the grassroots level — by listening to the community, understanding their challenges, and working together to create sustainable solutions. Children who had dropped out or had never been to school are now enrolled in formal education, giving them a chance at a brighter future. Elderly beneficiaries, especially those from underprivileged backgrounds, have been linked to free cataract surgery programs, restoring not just their vision, but also their independence. Through our regular community mobilisation drives, we have been able to identify unskilled youth and have connected them with our skill-based vocational training to help them secure better livelihoods. For working mothers, we've provided a safe and nurturing space for their children through our day care centres, ensuring access to nutritional food and quality early education.

In addition, our teams are actively helping vulnerable families connect with government schemes they were previously unaware of, empowering them with access to healthcare, education, and financial support. This is the true power of community mobilisation — creating awareness, bridging gaps, and bringing lasting change from the ground up.



Skill Labs are Shaping the Next Generation of Learners

In today's rapidly evolving world, the demand for future-ready skills is greater than ever. As industries continue to adapt to digital transformation and automation, it is essential that children and youth are equipped not just with knowledge, but with confidence and practical skills that prepare them for the real world.

At NIPUN, our Umang Vocational Unit is doing exactly that — shaping the next generation of learners through hands-on skill training. Located in South West and West Delhi, the Vocational Unit is empowering underprivileged youth, especially girls and women, with market-relevant skills that lead to meaningful employment and self-reliance. Over the course of the project, hundreds of young people have been trained in Basic Computer skills, Dress Designing, Beauty & Wellness, and Tally and Accounting. These vocational courses are not just lessons — they are stepping stones to independence. More than 72% of our trainees have already secured jobs or launched their own ventures, proving that access to the right skills can truly change lives.

To enhance learning, trainees also participate in exposure visits to BPOs, spas, beauty parlours, CA firms, retail stores, schools, and NGOs — giving them valuable real-world insights and raising their aspirations. Vocational Training Center or the Skill Labs like ours are more than classrooms — they are gateways to brighter futures. At NIPUN, we're proud to be shaping confident, capable, and skilled learners ready to take on the world.



Empowering Women: Awareness Session on Domestic Violence

On May 22, 2025, NIPUN, in collaboration with the West District Legal Services Authority under the jurisdiction of the High Court of Delhi, conducted a vital awareness session on domestic violence and the legal procedures for filing complaints. Held at the J.J. Clusters in Meera Bagh, West Delhi, the session saw active participation from 30 local women. The initiative aimed to equip them with essential knowledge and resources to effectively address and respond to instances of domestic violence.

Adv. Shri Jatin Dhamija, the session's resource person, played a pivotal role in guiding the participants through legal frameworks and support systems available to them. His insights fostered an open and empowering dialogue. A Question & Answer session followed, allowing participants to clarify their doubts and engage directly with the expert, making the discussion more impactful and participatory. This initiative reflects NIPUN's steadfast commitment to empowering women and advocating for their safety, dignity, and rights within the community.



Evenings of Care, Hope & Healing at Swavalamban Clinic

To improve the quality of life for the large migrant and daily wage worker population in Kapashera, South West Delhi, NIPUN runs the Swavalamban Evening Health Clinic—a charitable healthcare initiative that provides both preventive and curative services to underserved communities. The clinic offers consultations with specialized doctors on designated days and regularly organizes health camps focused on general checkups, eye screenings, gynecology, child healthcare, and cataract referrals. These services ensure that individuals who often ignore early symptoms due to lack of access or time can receive timely medical attention.

In addition to clinical care, the clinic also conducts awareness workshops to educate the community about common diseases—their causes, consequences, and preventive measures. This holistic approach to healthcare empowers people with the knowledge and resources to lead healthier lives.

Last month alone, the clinic served over ___ patients and facilitated successful cataract surgeries for four beneficiaries, showcasing its growing impact. By making quality healthcare accessible to those who need it most, the Swavalamban Evening Clinic is playing a vital role in building a healthier and more resilient community.






Menstrual Hygiene Day 2025: Creating a Period Friendly World

Menstrual Hygiene Day 2025 was observed with the theme "Together for a <u>#PeriodFriendlyWorld</u>," highlighting the importance of safe, dignified, and accessible menstrual hygiene management for all. The theme calls for breaking the silence around menstruation and ensuring that it does not hinder anyone's progress in life. Celebrated annually on May 28th, this day serves as a global platform to raise awareness, challenge taboos, and advocate for better menstrual health and hygiene.

Throughout the week, NIPUN, organized a series of impactful activities across our communities. These included awareness rallies, sensitization programs, focused group discussions, poster campaigns, and experience-sharing sessions. To further support menstrual health, we also distributed sanitary pads to over 250 adolescent girls and women including the construction workers and daily wage labourers, ensuring they have access to essential resources.

One of our community members, Jyoti, shared her thoughts: "The community is changing. The efforts NIPUN is making are gradually transforming the way people think." These words reflect the positive shift taking place, thanks to consistent awareness and empowerment initiatives. Through these efforts, we aim to empower girls and women, promote gender equality, and dismantle the long-standing taboos surrounding menstruation. Together, we are working toward building a more informed, inclusive, and period-friendly world.





Inclusive Healthcare for All: Health Camp for Transgender Community by NIPUN

On 29th May 2025, NIPUN Clinic organized a dedicated Health Check-up Camp for the transgender community in the South-West District of Delhi.

This initiative aimed to promote inclusive healthcare by providing comprehensive medical check-ups, free medicines, and referrals to AIIMS for advanced care.

The camp began with an awareness session by Dr. K. Mishra. who addressed common myths and misconceptions around HIV/AIDS, STIs, and related health concerns, fostering a safe informative and environment for the participants.

A total of 24 transgender individuals benefitted from the health services.

In addition, the camp facilitated community-based testing, group interactions, and one-on-one counselling sessions to ensure holistic well-being.

NIPUN remains committed to advancing equitable healthcare and supporting marginalized communities with dignity and respect.

World No Tobacco Day: Theme 2025: "Bright Products. Dark Intentions. Unmasking the Appeal"

Tobacco remains one of the deadliest substances abused globally. To highlight its devastating impact, the World Health Organization (WHO) observes World No Tobacco Day every year on May 31—aiming to inform the public about the dangers of tobacco consumption. This year's theme shines a spotlight on how the tobacco industry is increasingly targeting youth through attractive packaging, flavored products, and strategic marketing—disguising harm behind a facade of appeal.

To mark the day, we organized a sensitization and awareness program for youth, construction workers, and community members, educating them on the harmful effects of tobacco—including its links to cancer, heart disease, and respiratory illnesses.
