NIPUN's Recognition on World AIDS Day 2024 for Transgender Community Support

In collaboration with the Delhi State AIDS Control Society and NACO, NIPUN is implementing a Targeted Intervention project for the transgender community in Kapashera and surrounding areas of South West Delhi. This initiative focuses on enhancing healthcare access, reducing social stigma, and addressing economic vulnerabilities.

On World AIDS Day 2024, NIPUN was honored as one of the best Implementing Partners in a program organized by the Delhi State AIDS Control Society, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, at the auditorium of Dr. BSA Hospital, Sector-6, Rohini, Delhi. Additionally, Shri. NIPUN Observed Human Rights Day 2024

The theme for Human Rights Day 2024 is "Our Rights, Our Future, Right Now," emphasizing the everyday impact of human rights on people's lives. Human Rights Day is celebrated annually on December 10.

In collaboration with the West District Legal Services Authority, under the aegis of NALSA and DSLSA, NIPUN organized a legal awareness session on the topic "Legal Safeguards Against Harassment and Assault and the Role of DSLSA/DLSA in Providing Legal Assistance." The session was held for the women of the Bengali Camp and Meera Bagh J.J. Cluster, with support from Advocate Pawan Kumar of the Delhi State Legal Services Authority.

During the session, 40 women actively participated, posed questions, and enriched their understanding of legal safeguards and available assistance. Certificate Distribution Ceremony for Successful Adolescent Trainees at NIPUN

A Certificate Distribution Ceremony was recently held for 120 adolescent trainees who completed a 6-month course in Tally & Accounting, Beauty & Wellness, Self-Employed Tailoring, and Basic Computers from NIPUN-Umang Vocational Training Unit.

Shri. Pradeep Kumar, Founder & Secretary of NIPUN, encouraged the trainees to strive for self-reliance. He highlighted that more than 65% of the trainees secured job placements, and some have even launched their own ventures. Successful candidates like Neetu (Indigo Airlines), Deepesh (Export Unit), and Huma (Beauty Parlour owner) shared their inspiring journeys and the positive impact of their training.





NIPUN Empowers Mothers with Nutritional Awareness

On December 5th, 2024, NIPUN, in collaboration with Mahaveer International and Container Corporation of India Ltd. (CONCOR), conducted an awareness program for expecting and lactating mothers in South West District of Delhi.

The session, led by a resource person and her team, delivered crucial insights through interactive discussions and video presentations. The focus was on ensuring proper nutrition during pregnancy and lactation. Key recommendations included increasing food intake during pregnancy, incorporating whole grains, sprouted grams, and fermented foods into daily meals, consuming adequate amounts of milk, meat, or eggs, and including plenty of vegetables and fruits in the diet. Participants were also advised to avoid food taboos and superstitions, and to regularly take iron, folate, and calcium supplements starting from the 14th to 16th week of pregnancy through the lactation period. To support the mothers further, goody bags containing baby kits, sanitary napkins, kala chana, groundnuts, and sattu packets were distributed to all 32 participants.












The National Mathematics Day is observed on December 22 every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of the great Indian mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan.

Providing Hope and Healthcare in Kapashera



Women and children remain especially vulnerable to communicable diseases. To address this urgent need, we launched the Swavalamban Evening Clinic in 2017. Operating from 4–6 PM, this charitable clinic provides preventive and curative healthcare services to the underserved. With specialized doctors, including General Physicians, Gynecologists, Pediatricians, and Dentists, the clinic has served over 35,800 patients to date.

Eye treatments alone have benefited more than 3,200 individuals, with spectacles distributed and free cataract surgeries facilitated for 58 patients.

We also organize health camps and awareness workshops to educate families on disease prevention and the importance of timely treatment. However, due to financial challenges, we've had to scale down operations. Currently, the clinic runs limited services, with just one volunteer doctor visiting weekly and an eye care program. We need your support to revive and expand these critical healthcare services. Spreading Cancer Awareness

NIPUN, in collaboration with Cansupport, conducted an informative and empowering awareness session on Cancer Care for our community workers. The session covered a comprehensive range of topics, including the development and stages of cancer, highlighting how the disease progresses. महिलाओं को शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, स्वयं सहायता समूह निर्माण और कौशल शिक्षा जैसे कार्यक्रमों द्वारा उन्हें सशक्त एवंम आत्मनिर्भर बनाने के लिए प्रयासरत है। महिला सशक्तिकरण कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत संस्था लगातार समुदाय में रह रही महिलाओं और किशोरियों को घरेलू हिंसा रोकथाम, छेड़छाड़, यौन हिंसा, लैंगिक असमानता, लैंगिक भेदभाव और कन्या भ्रूण हत्या रोकथाम जैसे मुद्दों पर लगातार चर्चा द्वारा जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित करती रहती है और उनकी समस्याओं के समाधान के लिए उत्तरी जिला विधिक सेवा प्राधिकरण के सहयोग से संस्था उन्हें सेवाएं प्रदान करती रहती है और उनके समस्याओं का उनके दरवाजे पर ही समाधान करनेका प्रयास करते है। झुग्गी-झोपड़ियो की महिलाओं ने पोस्टर द्वारा बस्तीवासियो को जागरूक भी किया। संस्था सचिव प्रदीप कुमार ने सभी प्रतिभागियों से अनुरोध किया कि घरेलू हिंसा रोके, समुदाय की सभी लडिकयों को स्कूल भेजें और उत्तरी जिला विधिक सेवा प्राधिकरण द्वारा उपलब्ध कराई गयी सभी सेवाओं का ज्यादा से ज्यादा लाभ उठाएं और अपनी समस्याओं का समाधान करें। सुश्री सुधा गुप्ता ने सभी बहनों को जागरूक करते हुए विशेषतः किशोरियों की सुरक्षा, शराबखोरी, महिलाओं के अधिकारो आदि मद्दों पर विस्तत में चर्चा किया।
