DENTAL CHECK UP

According to a report, 95% Indians suffer from gum disease, 50% use a brush and only 2% of the population visit a dentist for check-ups.

NIPUN, in collaboration with the Indian Dental Association (IDA) organized a Dental Care cum check-up Camp at Basti Vikas Kendra, J.J. Cluster of Meera Bagh, West District, New Delhi on 2nd August 2022, sensitized the community and identified more than 200 children with cavity and teeth problems through door-to-door visits and awareness activities before the camp.

During the Dental Check-up camp, group session was undertaken by the IDA team for spreading awareness on oral hygiene and provided basic tools like toothbrush, toothpaste, etc. to maintain oral hygiene along with necessary medicines. 78 women and 322 children were examined by the dentists along with counseling regarding proper brushing. NIPUN's team and children thanked the dentists and para-medical staff for rendering their selfless service to the underprivileged society.



WORLD BREASTFEEDING WEEK

World Breastfeeding week is celebrated every year from 1-7th August to encourage breastfeeding and improve the health of children around the world. NIPUN is running Day Care Centres with the support of Mobile Creches at construction sites and urban slums for all round development of the children. Day Care Centre Workers sensitized mothers group at construction sites & urban slums on the importance of breastfeeding for better growth of the child, hygiene, doubts and myths on breastfeeding.

ORIENTATION SESSION ON MONEKYPOX

World Health Organization (WHO) declared Monkeypox as a global health emergency on 23rd July 2022.

During the orientation session, Information Education and Communication (IEC) materials developed by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India were handed over to the volunteers/Community Educators for further awareness programme in the underprivileged society. Queries related to the Monkeypox were clarified to all the participants through questions and answers.

PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

NIPUN organised Parents Education Programme on 24th August 2022 at Basti Pathshala, West Delhi District. During the discussion, teachers shared that parents are their child's first teachers and have the primary responsibility for the child's development.

NIPUN organised an awareness session with the parents of preschool children to educate them about different aspects of child development, health and nutrition, pedagogy of the preschool education and type of activities. Resource Person requested parents to provide support for learning at home, taught simple skills of recitation, story telling, preparation of puppets and low-cost fun to toys, etc.



SENSITIZATION ON DENTAL CARE

In India, about 85% to 90% of adults have dental cavities, along with about 60% to 80% of children. Around 30% of children have misaligned jaws and teeth. Over 50% of Indians with dental issues receive treatment or advice from someone other than dentist. About 21% Indians use a toothbrush and toothpaste to brush their teeth.

A team of Dentists from Indian Dental Association conducted an awareness session with mothers group of NIPUN-Day Care Centre at Bengali Camp, West District, New Delhi.

Maintaining oral hygiene, brushing teeth properly and avoiding or eliminating use of tobacco in daily life were key discussion points. We are extremely grateful to the Indian Dental Association for providing dental care services to the underprivileged society at their door step.

RIGHT TO FREE & COMPULSORY EDUCATION, 2009

West District Legal Services Authority organized an awareness session on Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 at NIPUN- Basti Pathshala, J.J. Cluster, Meera Bagh, New Delhi on 30.08.2022.

Before concluding the event, NIPUN team organised lunch for all the children.

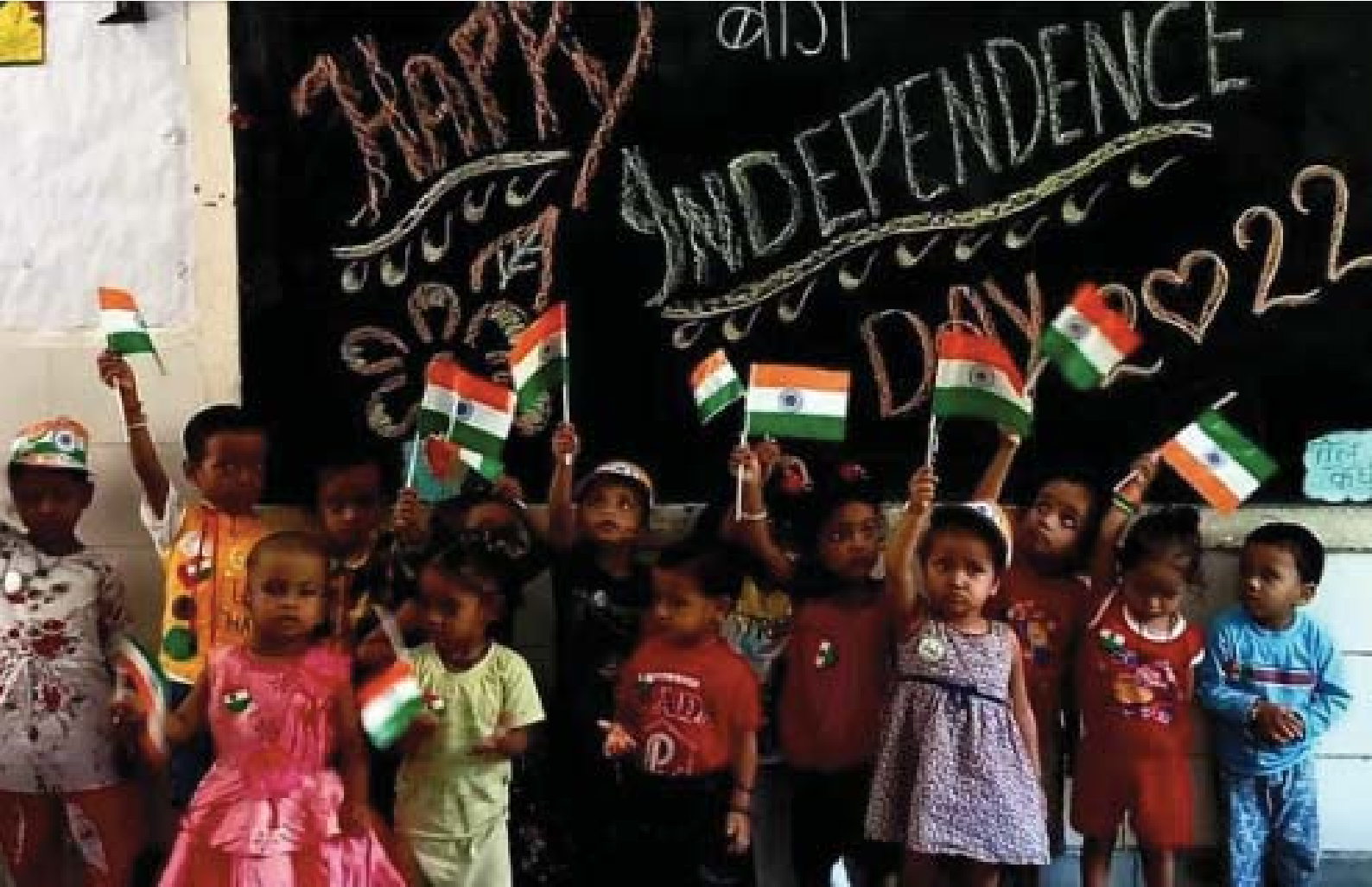


TINY TOTS OF DAY CARE CENTRES CELEBRATED 75TH I-DAY AT NDMC SCHOOLS
