For their holistic development, we conduct physical, mental, social, language & cognitive developmental activities using various teaching-learning tools, storytelling sessions, recitation, etc. We also provide supplementary nutrition to every child enrolled at our centre.

NIPUN congratulates the students who have appeared and passed the board examination of Secondary (X) & Senior Secondary (XII) level. All these children belong from the underprivileged sector staying in the J.J. Colonies and urban slums of Delhi/NCR and most of them are either dropped out from school or have never been to school and are firstgeneration learners. Our staff has motivated the parents who are majorly illiterate and daily wage laborers to send their children to our education centers and enrolled them in remedial and non-formal education centers and eventually mainstreamed them to the nearby Govt. Schools.

Esha, has passed her class Xth board exams with flying colours. She said that she aspires to become a Police officer and serve the public one day. During COVID pandemic, she faced difficulties due to non-availability of a smartphone and was not tech savvy either. But NIPUN staff walked an extra mile and ensured every possible support.
