Motivational Workshop for the dropout Children

An Art & Craft workshop was organised with the support of CCRT, Govt of India for the dropout and never been to school children in the age group of 8 years to 12 years residing in slum clusters.

The main purpose of the workshop was to motivate and attract the children and develop interest towards education and mainstream them in the current academic session.

During the five days art and craft workshop, 55 girls and boys joyfully attended and enjoyed learning skills using waste materials like: wall hanging, greeting cards, photo frame etc. Most of the children showed willingness to join regular School. The parents were also motivated to visit Government Schools and enroll them at the earliest.

NIPUN is working to ameliorate the

living conditions of the vulnerable sections of society living slums/resettlement colonies and facilitating socio-economic empowerment of women through a number of direct and indirect services. There is a need to address Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH) situation slums/communities, as the women and children bear the maximum brunt of inadequate water and sanitation infrastructure. Inadequate access to safe water and sanitation services, coupled with poor hygiene practices, is the cause of at least one-quarter of all child deaths and one-fifth of the total childhood disease burden globlally.

NIPUN organized a community awareness campaign "School Chalo Abhiyan" across all the project locations of NIPUN at Delhi order to ensure maximum enrollment the MCD/ Govt. Schools during the current academic session.

main purpose of campaign was to raise awareness among children and parents about the importance of school education. During the campaign, the children and staff of NIPUN organized rallies and moved around the community shouting various slogans like 'Beta Beti Ek Saman, Sabko Shiksha, Sabko Gyan'.

The staff also made door-to-door visits to motivate the parents to send their wards to schools who dropped out from schools during Covid-19 pandemic.



To address the issue of Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH), the youth of the community organized a series of campaigns by organizing rallies, door-to-door visits, individual and group counselling, etc to motivate the community on personal health and hygiene.

"Book Reading Campaign - 2022"

NIPUN organised Book Reading Campaign 2022 for the children of slum clusters located at South East, West and South West Districts in Delhi from 10th April to 18th April 2022.



The main objective of the book reading campaign was to inculcate the habits of book reading in Hindi and English freely at the primary level.

During the COVID-19 lockdown book reading habit of the students was interrupted due to lack of continuous teaching.

During the book reading campaign motivation level of children was high.

It was also observed that only 50% to 60% of the students of classes IIIrd, IVth and Vth standards were found capable to readout books properly in hindi and english.

A total of 120 children (62 F; 58 M) of above classes actively participated.

NIPUN Team worked out an action plan to strenghen the habits of reading books through extra Remedial Classes.

According to Neha of Class Vth student of Govt School " Ham NIPUN -Remedial Education ki classes roj attend karnge auar apni Hindi ki kitab farratte se padne lagenge" NIPUN team distributed appreciation prizes to best students who readout book properly.
